### Ranching Heritage Association Working Cowboy Award

The Ranching Heritage Association (RHA) Working Cowboy Award recognizes outstanding individuals who make a living primarily in the saddle caring for livestock and the land on a daily basis. The recipient must be skilled in all aspects of ranch work and respected by the ranch crew and ranching community. Each year, two awards are presented: one to a cowboy from the Rocky Mountain and Western states, and one to a cowboy from the states east of the Rockies.

#### Award Qualifications:

- Makes their living full-time as a cowboy
- Works primarily horseback
- Possesses the necessary skills to care for and raise stock humanely and efficiently
- Is a person of exemplary character, who rides for the brand and is an asset to his or her community and ranch

The Working Cowboy Award recipient is selected by a committee of ranching peers from nominations received. One recipient is chosen annually from this national pool. The winner is recognized at the National Golden Spur Award Honors event and presented with custom spurs and a \$5,000 cash award.
